

# Dating Do's and Don'ts

Do's	Don'ts
<p><b>Actively listen when you are on a date</b></p>	<p><b>Talk endlessly about your favourite subjects</b></p>
<p><b>Take time to ease yourself into a relationship</b></p>	<p><b>Expect your date to always behave in predictable ways</b></p>
<p><b>Ask before kissing someone on a date</b></p>	<p><b>Insist on keeping the relationship going even if the other person doesn't want to</b></p>
<p><b>Show respect to the other person's wishes</b></p>	<p><b>Expect the first date to go perfectly every time</b></p>
<p><b>Be alert to signals that show whether or not the boy/girl is interested in you</b></p>	<p><b>Persist on asking someone out many times even if they keep saying "no"</b></p>
<p><b>Speak privately with the other person when you are going to ask them for a date</b></p>	<p><b>Stand very close to your date the first time you go out</b></p>
<p><b>Know what to do if your date starts acting inappropriately towards you</b></p>	<p><b>Drink a lot of alcohol on your first date</b></p>
<p><b>Think of some topics ahead of time that you and your partner might want to discuss on your date</b></p>	<p><b>Always expect the boy/girl to kiss you on the lips after your first date</b></p>
